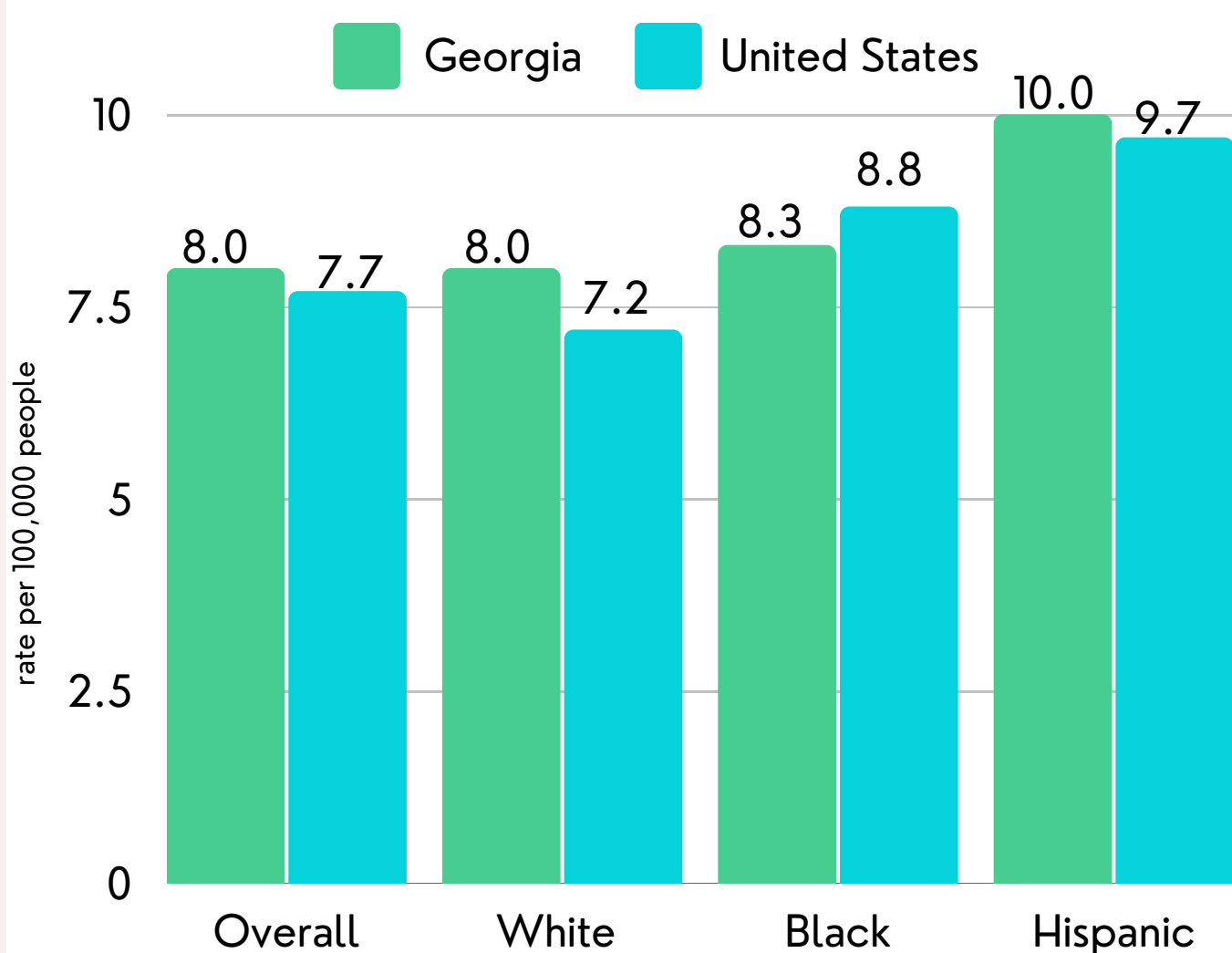


Cervical Cancer Incidence & Mortality, GA, 2015-2019

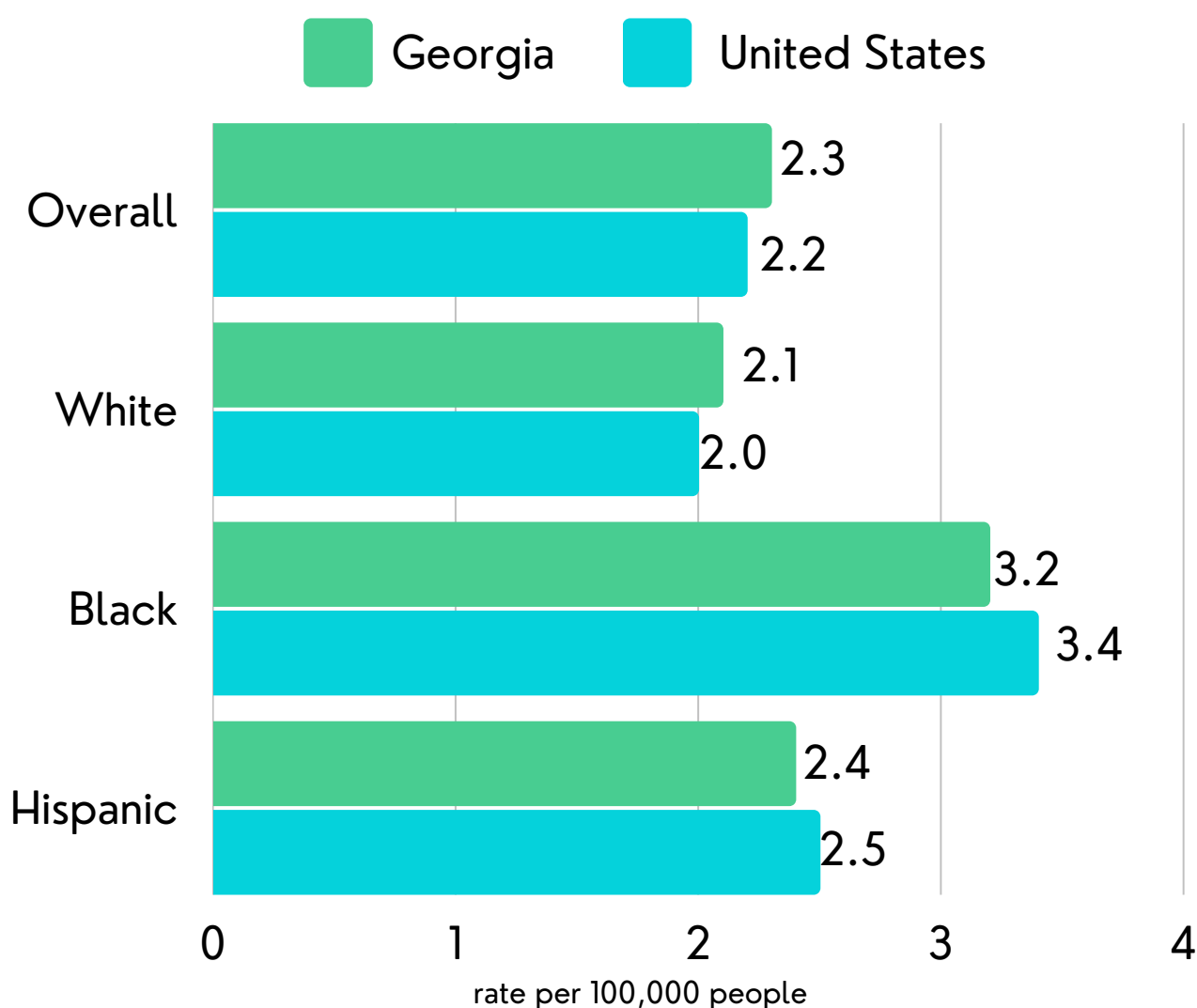
Incidence



In Georgia, the rate of new cervical cancer cases (8.0) exceeds the national average (7.7).

Hispanic women have a higher rate of new cervical cancer cases compared to women of other races/ethnicities.

Mortality



The cervical cancer death rate in Georgia (2.3) is higher than the national average (2.2).

Black women are more likely to die from cervical cancer than women of other races/ethnicities statewide.
