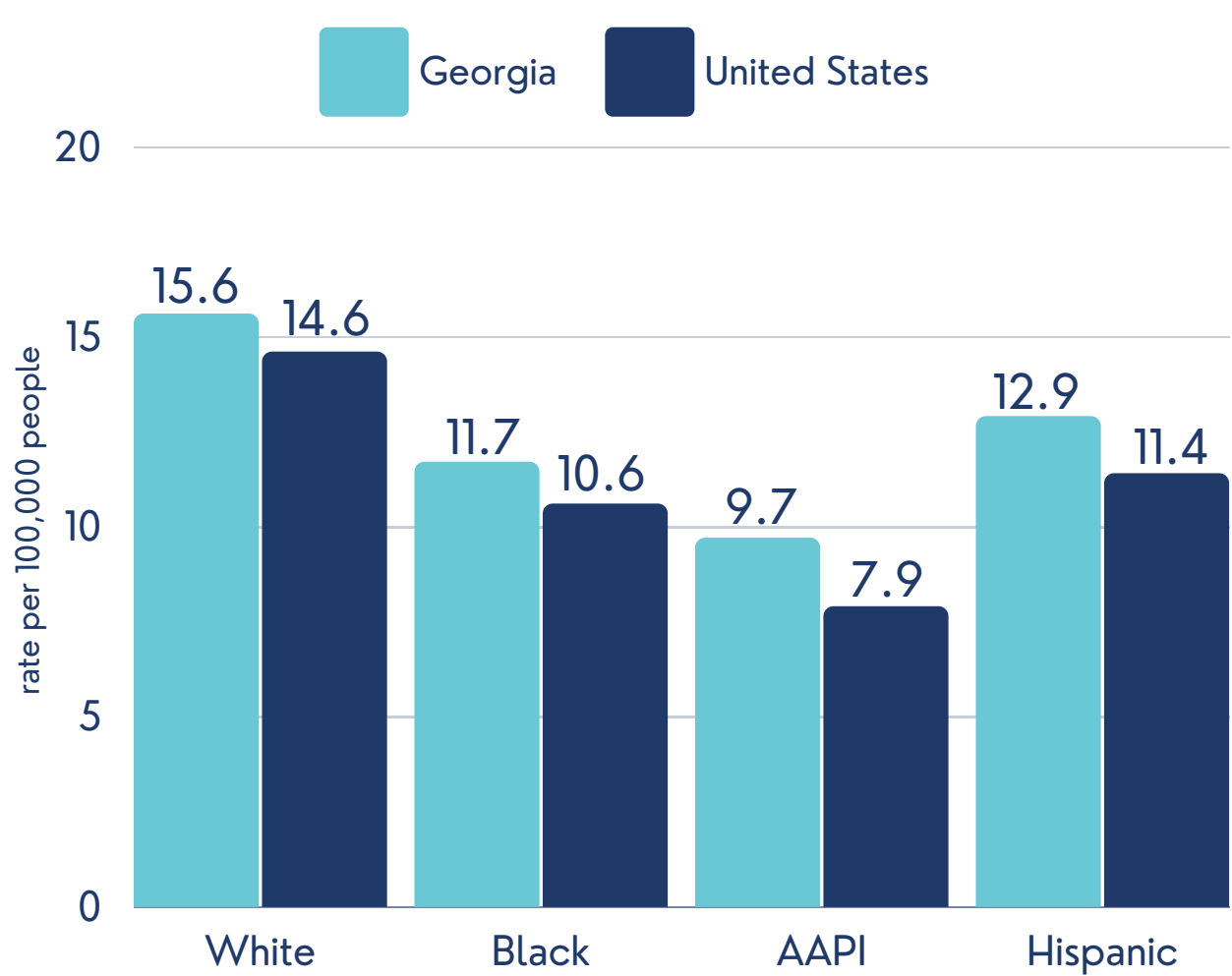


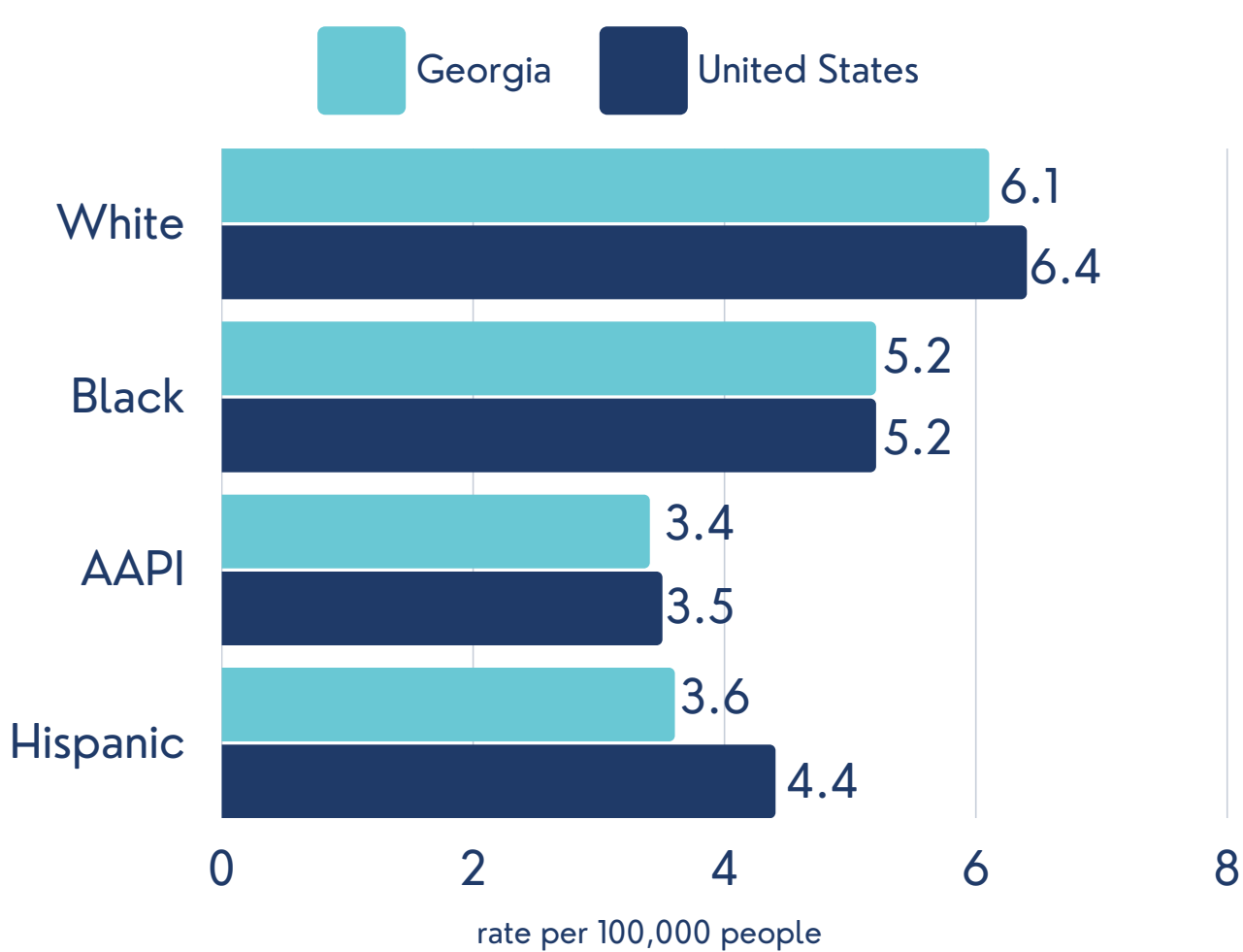
Leukemia Incidence and Mortality, GA, 2015-2019

Incidence



The leukemia incidence rate in Georgia (14.4 per 100,000 people) is higher than the national average (14.1 per 100,000 people) for all racial/ethnic groups. In both Georgia and the United States, White people have the highest rate of new leukemia cases.

Mortality



Overall, the leukemia mortality rate in Georgia (5.8 per 100,000 people) is below the national average (6.1 per 100,000 people). In Georgia, White people have the highest mortality rate compared to other races/ethnicities.
