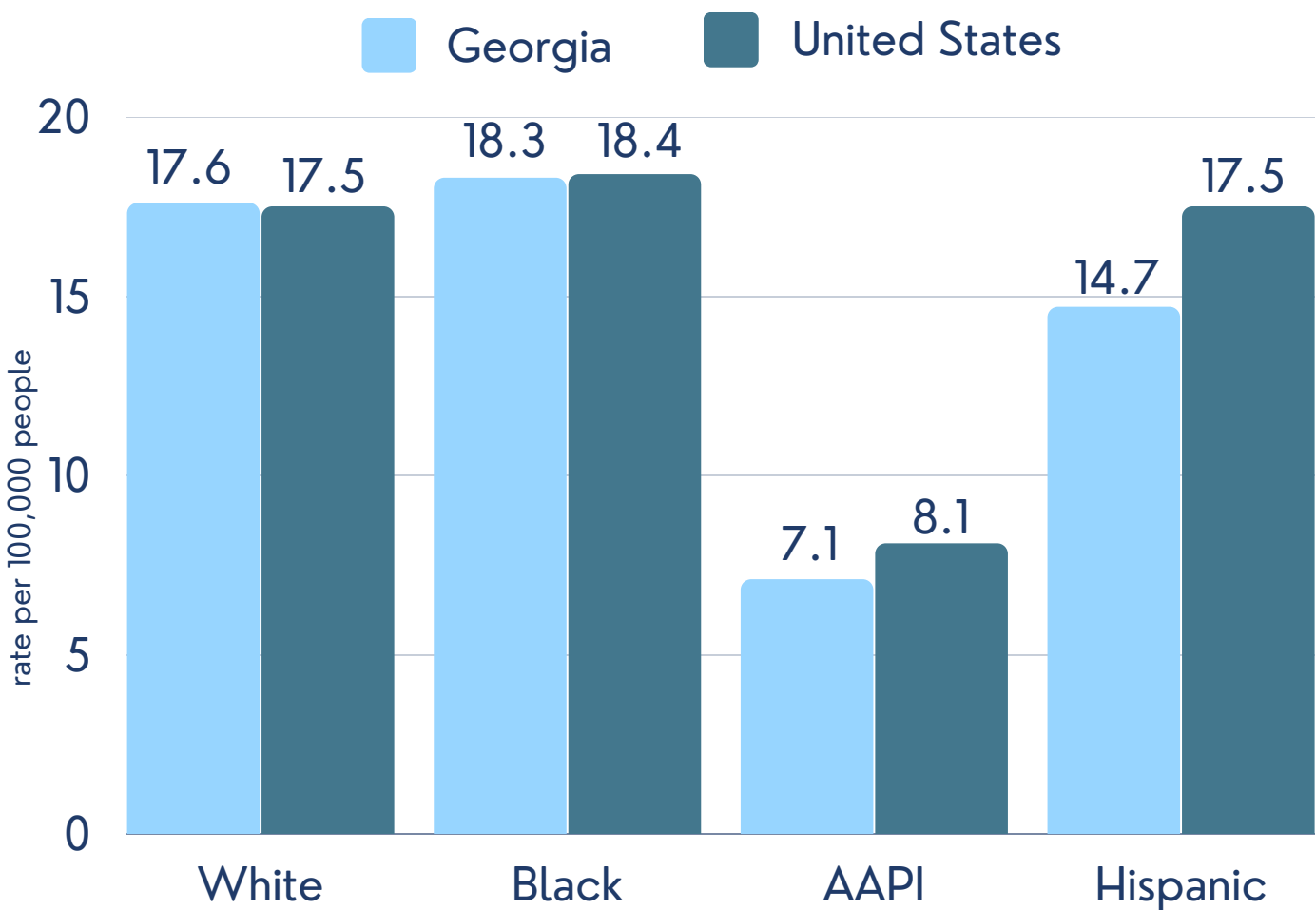


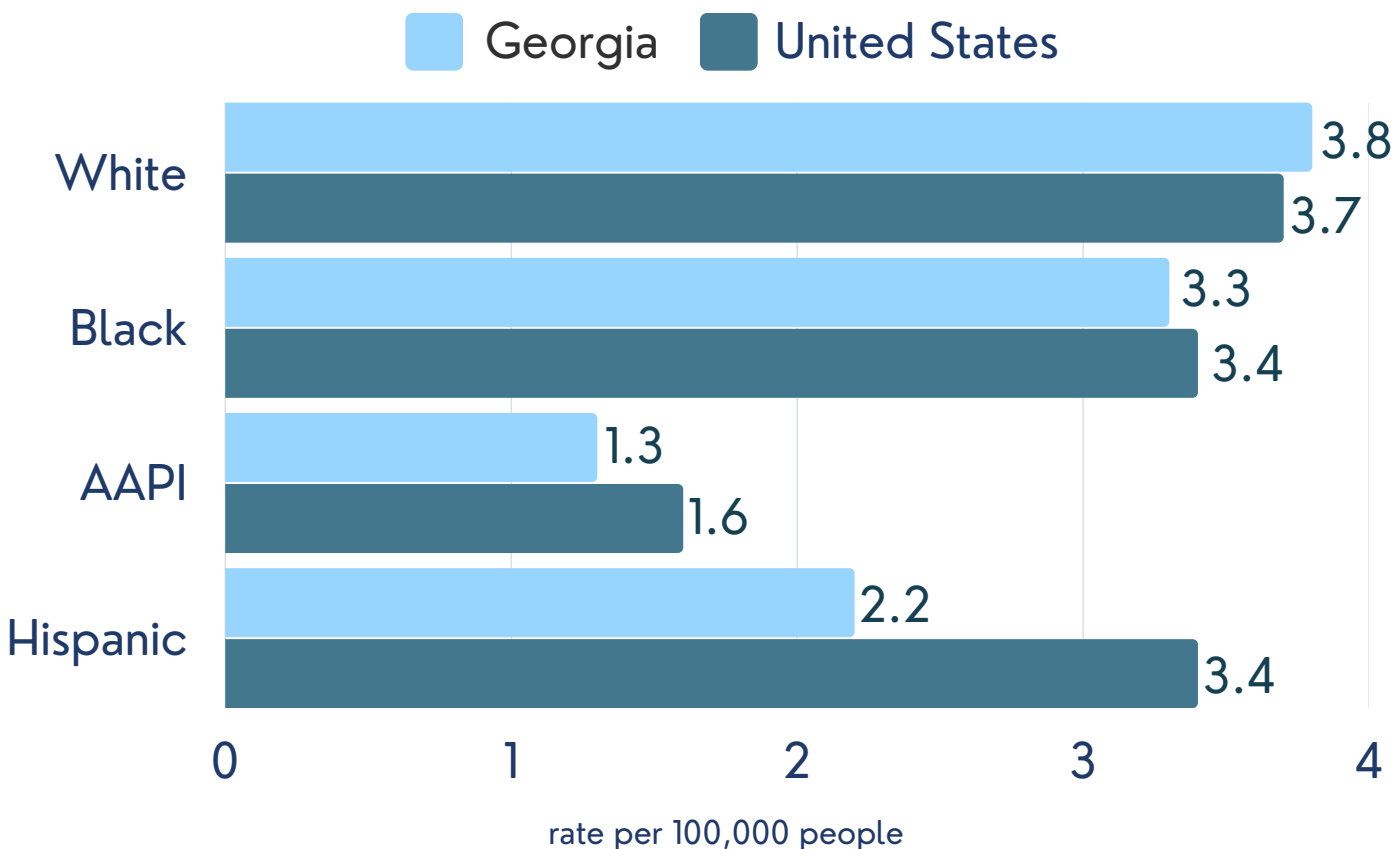
Kidney & Renal Pelvis Incidence and Mortality, GA, 2015-2019

Incidence



In Georgia, the overall kidney and renal pelvis incidence rate is 17.4 per 100,000 people while the national average is 17.3 per 100,000. The rate of new kidney and renal pelvis cancer cases is higher among Black people than other races/ethnicities.

Mortality



When comparing Georgia and the U.S., there is no difference in the kidney and renal pelvis cancer mortality rate. Both have a mortality rate of 3.6 per 100,000 people. Interestingly, White people have a greater mortality rate compared to Black people although their rate of new cases less than the rate of Black people.
