

# Summer Scholars Research Program FAQs

## Transportation

### **1. Does the Summer Scholars Research Program provide transportation?**

*SSRP does not provide transportation for students. Students will need to purchase a temporary [Emory Healthcare](#) employee parking permit from the Emory Transportation and Parking Office if they wish to park on campus.*

### **2. What are the available transportation options for SSRP students?**

*There are many [transportation options](#) on Emory's campus including the [Emory Shuttles](#) and the [Gwinnett County Transit](#). **We recommend the Emory Shuttles which reaches any area around campus and is free for everyone.***

*Students MUST indicate their primary source of transportation for the program on the Student Emergency Contact Information Tab of the [SSRP Portal](#). If students plan on using Uber, Lyft, or other ridesharing apps, parents must e-mail [ssrp@emory.edu](mailto:ssrp@emory.edu) acknowledging that they are allowing their child to use ridesharing apps.*

### **3. How do you purchase a temporary parking permit?**

*To purchase a parking permit, fill out the [Emory University/Healthcare Parking Permit Form](#) (or view the form [here](#)) and take it to Emory's Parking Office (Clairmont Campus: 1945 Starvine Way, Suite 400B, the office just behind the shuttle circle at the Starvine parking deck). You can take the C, E, or Loop Shuttle from the main campus or use the Starvine Visitor Lot – enter from the lower back part of the deck - while you visit the Parking Office, the first 30 minutes are free (enough time to obtain the permit at the office). Once you turn in the form and make the payment, you will be issued a permit for your designated parking deck.*

*We recommend arranging your transportation in advance of the program to facilitate a seamless transition when the program begins.*

### **4. Where will SSRP students be parking?**

*Optimal parking locations are Starvine or Lowergate South decks if available. Other available locations are the Michael Street and Peavine decks. You can find more information on the deck locations [here](#).*

### **5. How are Summer Scholars Students transported to fieldtrips?**

*Students are responsible for transporting themselves to fieldtrip locations. All fieldtrips can be reached by Emory's shuttles and in previous years, students have planned to ride the shuttle together. More information on which shuttle to take for each fieldtrip will be given once the program begins.*
